Re: Consolidation of MSSA/MRSA Screening Orders

The process for ordering Staphylococcus aureus screening will be updated as follows:

Order Consolidation

- The current separate orders for Nose Culture Screen (Mnemonic: NOSECU) and MRSA Screen (Mnemonic: MRSACU) will be retired.
- A new consolidated order, MSSA/MRSA Screen (Mnemonic: MSSA.MRSA), will replace both.

Specimen Requirements

- Acceptable specimen: Bacterial swab (ex. Copan E-Swab), primarily from the nasal cavity.
- Purpose: To screen for colonization with MSSA (Methicillin-Sensitive *Staphylococcus* aureus) and MRSA (Methicillin-Resistant *Staphylococcus* aureus).

Rationale

This update eliminates duplicate ordering pathways and creates a standardized approach for *S. aureus* colonization screening across sites.

The change will be implemented first in the urban Eastern zone, with plans for a province wide rollout to follow in a phased manner. When the change has been implemented in each zone, a pop-up box will indicate ordering of MMSA.MRSA instead of NOSECU or MRSACU.
